# FROM THE RABBI



As I approach the end of my 22-year tenure as Rabbi of B'nai Sholom, I am often asked: so, what are you going to <u>do</u> with yourself, after you retire? Well, I actually have quite a long list of things to do! Here are some of them:

<u>Teach</u>: While I will be cutting back on my teaching at Marshall - I <u>am</u> retiring, after all! - I will continue to teach my classes in "The Holocaust" and "The Hebrew Prophets," my areas of greatest expertise. There is no one else in this area who is qualified to teach these courses, and I think it is important that these classes remain part of the Religion Department at Marshall. While doing this teaching, I also plan to:

Write: I hope to write at least two books, relating to the aforementioned areas of my expertise, and growing out of my many decades of teaching and research. One will be on "Causes of the Holocaust," and one on "The Most Important Prophet: Amos." I believe that these works will be important contributions to the fields of Jewish/Religious Studies. In addition to this, I will:

<u>Travel</u>: Tori and I are going to visit a number of places we've never been (China!); and we hope to revisit some places we've seen, but would like to see again (Australia! Alaska! Cincinnati!) We will in fact be going to China this July, right after I retire! But of course, we also plan to:

<u>Visit</u>: The most important part of our travels: more visits - a <u>lot</u> more - to Charlotte, North Carolina to see our grandchildren, Jacob and Jonah. We hope to spend more time with all our relatives. And, in addition to this:

<u>Wellness Program</u>: I have tried, as best I could, to take care of this congregation over the years; but I have done a poor job of taking care of myself.

I need to enroll, this fall, in some kind of "Senior Citizens' Exercise" program (I am now clearly eligible!), to walk a lot more, to eat more salads, and etc. They say it's "never too late to start" this sort of program, and I certainly hope that they're right! And I'm also going to take time, for the first time in decades, for a:

<u>Hobby</u>: I've never really had time for hobbies, (except for the occasional Yankees game). But I'm going to have one now, and some of you know what it is. For those who don't: if you should happen to visit a "Civil War Re-Enactment Camp" during the next few years, you may encounter a Union Chaplain, a Rabbi from 1863, who looks a <u>lot</u> like a Rabbi whom you already know! And, speaking of Rabbis, I'm also going to be your:

Rabbi Emeritus of B'nai Sholom: which is a fancy way of saying that Tori and I will still be here, in Huntington and in our Jewish community, for the foreseeable future. And, whatever our future holds: I will always treasure our time here; and I will always pray that God will bless each and every one of youwith health and strength, with joy and peace, as I sign off, for the last time:
